### Wednesday, April 29: Final Reminder Call to Your Guests

• Place a reminder call/text to your guests. This is the key to getting your guests to the event. Other than inviting your guests this is your most important role in the breakfast!

## Wednesday, May 1, 2024 - THE BREAKFAST

- <u>7:00 a.m.</u> Arrive at the Embassy Suites Hotel and Concord Convention Center in time to register, find your table and your packet, and be there to greet your guests.
- Stand at your table so that your guests can find you and share the QR codes linking to event materials with your guests.
- Wait to distribute pledge envelopes to your guests until the *end* of breakfast, when you are instructed to do so. The reason for this is that the entire breakfast is carefully orchestrated to inspire generous giving if they fill out pledge cards early, they are likely to give less.
- Collect the pledge envelopes and return to the packet when you are instructed to do so.
- Return the packet to an arts council representative before you leave.
